PLAN YOUR RENOVATION

- ► Finalize your design and appliance selection with Scavolini Toronto
- ▶ Choose your contractor and define the scope of work needed:
 - Prior installation removal if required (i.e., remove your previous kitchen, bathroom, laundry, closet model)
 - Changes to electrical, gas, plumbing and structural changes (i.e. removal of walls or building new walls)
 - Replacement of flooring
 - Painting
 - HVAC changes
 - Use your Scavolini installation and mechanical drawings to plan renovation with your contractor
- ▶ **Apply for permits** if required for your renovation
- ▶ Plan how much time your contractor will need to prepare the space for the new kitchen, bathroom, laundry or living area based on the ETA we have provided
- ▶ Select and order any other finishes and materials you may need (flooring, lighting fixtures, tiles, etc.)
- ▶ **Start renovation** based on the ETA we have provided and the timeline your contractor defined

INSTALLATION

Your space is now ready for your new Scavolini installation. Together with your contractor you will have removed your old kitchen/bathroom/closet/living area products, prepared all electrical and plumbing, installed new flooring and painted the walls.

Now it is time for our installation team to deliver and install your new product. Our team of installers are trained and experienced in delivering the precision of fit and craftsmanship that define a Scavolini home.



Before your installation date

- Declutter, pack up or move any non-essential items away from your renovation area.
- ▶ Think about where discarded materials go consider renting a large trash bin for garbage disposal.

On your installation date

- ▶ Ensure protective coverings are in place for furniture, electronics, carpeting or flooring.
- ▶ Be onsite to meet with your general contractor.
- ▶ For a kitchen install, once the cabinets are installed, the countertops can be templated. It takes approximately 3 weeks for your countertops to be installed and this is a good time to have an electrician and plumber to do all the necessary connections.

After your installation date

Our team will be sure to leave your home tidy, but you may want to consider booking a professional cleaner, or setting aside time to further clean your renovation area.

HOW TO

GUIDE TO MEASURING

STEP 1

Draw the shape of your room. Note that it does not have to be to scale or to proportion.

STEP 2

Make note of windows, doors and openings.

STEP 3


Draw in any other obstacles such as radiators, vent columns and bulkheads.

STEP 4

Begin taking measurements of your walls, windows, doorways and obstacles. It's important to remember that we are looking for usable wall space. This means measuring from the corner to the outside of window/door casings.

STEP 5

Measure the height of your windows: bottom of the sill to top of the casing, (WH). Measure the distance from the floor to the bottom of the sill - this is called AFF, above finished floor. This will help us determine if standard cabinetry can be located under windows.




STEP 6


Measure your ceiling height in the areas where cabinetry may touch the ceiling, as sometimes ceiling heights can vary from one side of the room to the other. Measure the heights of the bulkheads.

STEP 7

For the kitchen design, measure the center line (CL) of your current sink to the nearest wall if the sink must remain in the same location. Same goes for the range.
